

# WESTON WITH GAYTON PARISH COUNCIL

**Minutes of the Extraordinary Parish Council Meeting that took place on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> August 2017 in Weston Village Hall at 7.30pm**

## **REQUEST FROM THE WOOLPACK PH FOR USE OF THE VILLAGE GREEN**

**1668.** The meeting was called to discuss a request from The Woolpack to use the small green opposite their premises for a B.B.Q. and bouncy castle on the first weekend in September.

**1669** A robust discussion took place, with regard to fees and charges. Whilst the suggestion was tabled to charge the full rate of £100 per day, it was largely felt that owing to the overall problems that the village have had with the demise of the facilities at the pub, a more lenient approach should be taken to offer a one off fee of £100 for the two days, with the clear stipulation that this is only for this one weekend.

**1670** The chairman informed the meeting that the Parish Council Chairman is qualified to undertake and review any required risk assessments and will undertake any necessary checks to ensure they have the appropriate insurance and detailed risk assessment in place before permission is granted.

**1671** It was agreed “use of the village green” will be added to the agenda of the next meeting.

**1672** The Chairman proposed that we should charge £100 for the weekend. This was agreed by a vote of 5 for and one against. **RESOLVED** – Councillor Hopkin to notify the manager of the Woolpack in writing, setting out their responsibilities as mentioned above.
